Edusave Character Award (ECHA)

1. The Edusave Character Award (ECHA) recognises students who demonstrate exemplary character and outstanding personal qualities through their behaviour and actions. The award also supports the school's continuing efforts in nurturing students of good values and character, who are active contributors and concerned citizens.
2. Eligibility Criteria:
The ECHA is meant to recognise and affirm students who demonstrated exemplary character and outstanding personal qualities through their behaviour and actions. Students must satisfy the following eligibility criteria before they can be given the ECHA:
 - a) Students must be Singaporeans studying in government/ government-aided primary or secondary schools, independent schools, specialised independent schools, specialised schools or junior colleges/ centralised institute (JC/CI); and
 - b) Students must, on a consistent basis, **demonstrate good character and values**. In particular, students may be identified for demonstrating the following types of qualities:
 - i. School values and/or character traits that the school wishes to recognise or encourage, e.g. Teamwork, Honesty, Innovativeness, Kindness, Enthusiasm, Resilience;
 - ii. A high level of civic responsibility. These would be students who are concerned about issues in the community or issues faced by others, initiating action to address these issues to improve the lives of others, and being committed to make a positive difference; and/or
 - iii. Qualities associated with resilience. These would be students who have persevered despite facing difficult circumstances (e.g. financial problems, family issues, health issues etc.), and managed to overcome the odds and still do commendably well in academic and non-academic domains.

3. The quantum of the award is as follows:

Levels	Award Quantum
Primary 1 to 3	\$200
Primary 4 to 6	\$350

4. Nominations for students can be put up by their peers, teaching and non-teaching staff as well as other stakeholders from **4 to 12 August 2025, 5 p.m.** For parents, please use this url (<https://go.gov.sg/echajwpsa2>) to nominate deserving students.
5. Shortlisted nominees will attend an endorsement by the panel, consisting of Principal/Vice-Principal, Head of Department (HOD), stakeholders and teachers.
6. The award will be presented to deserving students at the community level, together with the Edusave Scholarships, Edusave Merit Bursaries, Good Progress Awards and EAGLES.
