Attendance


In the event that your child is absent from school, your child **must submit** the relevant **documents** to his form teacher upon his return to school.

Gate 1 (opens at 6:30 am)


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Driving to School



How does it work?



School











- Instantaneous transactions
 - Increase daily limit
- Safe
 - Disable band function in case of loss / theft
- Convenience
 - Need not exchange for smaller notes for your child's allowance
 - Need not visit the bank to deposit your child's savings

Auto savings (Optional):

 Leftover allowance automatically transferred into POSBkids Account on a monthly basis

Snack Break (optional)


- About 12 noon

TRANSITION TO PRIMARY 1

When your child enters primary school, their experience will include:



- Guide your child to do the following independently:
 - ✓ Practise pre-bedtime routines to have at least 9 hours of sleep
 - Dress themselves
 - \checkmark Buy food at the canteen
 - ✓Make healthy food choices
 - ✓Wash their hands

✓Take their temperature using a thermometer

- Guide your child to do the following independently:
 - Ask for permission and seek help when needed
 - ✓ Clean themselves after using the toilet
- Train your child to pack his bag daily according to the timetable







Packing the school bag



"What are some items you will need?" "What lessons do you have tomorrow? What books do you need for these lessons?"

I will need my pencil case, school diary, hand sanitiser, water bottle...

Tomorrow I have English lessons, I should bring my exercise book...

- Items to bring to school everyday
 - ✓Water bottle
 - ✓ Student Handbook (distributed on 1st day of school)
 - Pencil case (with at least 3 pencils sharpened, an eraser and a ruler)
 - ✓A suitable storybook for silent reading
 - ✓ File/ folder for keeping homework and letters

- Ensure your child's belongings are labelled with a permanent marker/ waterproof sticker
 - ✓ Water bottle
 - ✓ Food containers (box and lid)
 - ✓ wallet



Attire and Appearance

- Students are to put on the prescribed uniforms. Modification to the school uniform is <u>not</u> allowed.
- Students are expected to have their name tags ironed/sewn on the school uniform, <u>above the</u> <u>school crest</u>.
- Jewellery/ Ornaments/ Accessories
 - 1 pair of small and simple ear-studs for girls only
 - Black/Dark blue hair accessories are permitted.

Building Partnership with the school

- Maintain regular communication through official school channels.
 - Have regular conversations with teachers in both academic and nonacademic areas - this will help you better guide your child's development
